DOCUMENTS FOR VEHICLE EXPORTATION

19 CFR PART 192



1. **LANDING DOCUMENTS-** (BILL OF LADING DULLY SIGNED IN ORIGINAL). BILL OF LADING MUST INCLUDE ITN NUMBER OR PROOF OF EEI FILING.
2. **ORIGINAL CERTIFICATE OF TITLE.**
3. **PRPD EXPORT CERTIFICATE-** (Vehiculos Hurtados PRPD) POLICIA DE PUERTO RICO.
4. **EXPORT POWER OF ATTORNEY-** If the owner of the vehicle to be exported is not presenting the documents to CBP, an Export Power of Attorney must be submitted and notarized, identifying the person submitting the documentation and signed by and identifying the ultimate purchaser/owner and the vehicle. (Important the vehicle identification number (VIN) must be noted in the document).
5. **LETTER OF AUTHORIZATION-** Corporate Resolution. If the vehicle to be exported is owned by a corporation, company or business entity, it must be accompanied by a notarized letter on official business letterhead authorizing an agent to act on its behalf and authorizing the exportation. If this is a sale an invoice must be presented along with all other documentation.
6. **LIENHOLDER AUTHORIZATION-** If the vehicle is leased or has a lien against it, there must be specific authorization allowing for the export of the vehicle on company, bank or institution's letterhead.
7. **PHOTO IDENTIFICATION-** Copy of the photo identification of the person presenting the export documents.
8. **PHOTO IDENTIFICATION-** Copy of the photo identification of the owner of the vehicle if different from the person presenting the export documents.
9. **For resident aliens, must present a passport or resident alien card.**
10. **BRING CAR FOR INSPECTION (3) DAYS (72 hours) BEFORE EXPORTATION.**
